What should I expect?

After you have been registered, you will be greeted by a Registered Sonographer that will take you back to an exam room, explain the exam and prepare you for the Ultrasound.

You may need to change into a gown in preparation for the exam. If you need help getting ready, please let the Sonographer know, they will be glad to help you.

Your exam should take approximately 30 minutes to approximately 1 hour to complete.

The Sonographer will apply warm ultrasound gel to your skin area and will rub a probe around on your skin to take images.

At any point during your exam you have questions, please let the technologist conducting your exam know. They will be glad to assist you.



What is an Ultrasound?

An Ultrasound exam uses sound waves to obtain images without the use of radiation.
